#### THE GENDER BINARY

Society defines certain traits as either 'masculine' vs 'feminine':



Independent Dominant Aggressive



Emotional Nurturing Generous

These traits perpetuate gender stereotypes and inform societal expectations for men and women.

### **MASCULINITY IDEOLOGY**

Masculine ideology sets the standard of what it means to be a 'good man' based on society's expectations and how well men conform to these expectations.

Society expects men to be powerful, tough, and to reject femininity.

## WHAT DOES INTERNALISED MASCULINE IDEOLOGY LOOK LIKE?

Men feel pressure is to be the primary earner in the family.

Women who work in male-dominated fields experience harassment.

Women penalize other women who are successful in traditionally masculine roles.

#### WHAT CAN BE DONE?

Traits need to be redefined so they are not limited to the masculine/feminine binary to relieve some of the pressure that masculine ideologies are enforcing on men.
